Rajasthan Parishad

Improvement of Infrastructure

Major infrastructure improvements were undertaken at one of our village school, GHS, Billa. The following were provided:

- 1. Green boards for Classrooms.
- 2. Book Almirahs for Library.
- 3. Mats for sitting of students in Classrooms.
- 4. Fans for Classrooms.

5. Major improvement work was done for the continuous supply of clean water for drinking and wash room purpose. Better water supply pipe line was replaced with two new over head tanks of 1000 litres capacity, have been fixed in addition to the old water tank. A water cooler alongwith water purifier have been insisted to meet the clean drinking water requirement of students.

Miscellaneous

A lecture was organized by the Secretary of **Rama Krishna Mission**, Chandigarh for celebration of 150th birth anniversary of **Swami Vivekananda**. Books by and about Swami Vivekananda were distributed in all our schools.

A lecture was organized by **Deputy Commissioner**, **Panchkula Ms. Ashima Brar** for all the Principals and Coordinators of our schools in Panchkula at Red Bishop, Panchkula. It was also attended by DEO, Panchkula. Ms. Brar emphasized to all the Principals to extend all possible help and support to the society, so that maximum number of students are helped.

Dr. Ranjana Malik delivered talks on **general hygiene** to girl students in Sector-7, Sector-15 and Saketri Schools of Panchkula.

A lecture was organized on **Personality Development** by **Shri S K Monga**, **IAS (Retd.)** to our college students. Such lessons were also delivered by Shri Monga in number of schools in Panchkula and Chandigarh. He also promised the students to play the role of mentor for those students who wanted to join the Civil Services.

Ms. Rita Chari wife of **Mr. Chari Chief General Manager** of State Bank of India, provided financial help to the tune of Rs. 15000/- for our three students pursuing Diploma in Mechanical Engineering. In addition she has also agreed to provide further infrastructure improvement in our village school, Billa and a Hostel of Girls from Leh at Ramgarh.

Uttarakhand Tragedy

Some members of the society and their friends donated money for sending much needed help for the Uttarakhand tragedy victims. 800 blankets at cost of Rs. 1,64,000/- were purchased and got distributed in the remote villages of Uttarakhand through the Army unit located at Rudraprayag
